MWBC BUDGET SET

The MWBC board concluded budget talks Dec. 2 with an approval of \$4.41M in funding toward research, market development, education and operations.

A total of 22 research projects were approved out of 25 submissions totaling \$1.93M in research investment.

Total budget expenditures approved are down about 8% from what was spent in 2024.


CONVENTIONS

MSU Research Rundown

By Sue Mondal -- In 2024, winter wheat grain yields were near a record



high of 50bu/ac. Even though the grain yields were higher a major concern that has been reported is the lower-than-normal protein ranging between 9-11 percent, resulting in discounts at elevators.
